### 3. Prayer support for Conference Leadership and ministries.

- a. Invite to join teleconference
- b. Visit once per month at conference meetings/prayer
- c. Prayer for various Conference events
- d. Work with Leadership to develop a "prayer ministry" in every ministry.
- e. Understand that "All ministry is birthed and sustained through ministry of prayer

#### 4. Prayer Support for Evangelism

- a. Develop Prayer Ministry for Evangelism teams in churches having meetings
- b. Work with evangelists/pastors/prayer team leaders in churches involved

- 5. Encourage all churches to develop "a culture of prayer."
  - a. Prayer /revival Week-ends in the local churches
  - b. Recruit Pastors/leaders/prayer leaders to help develop this concept
  - c. Provide resources
  - d. Provide opportunities/experiences through participation in local church and conference activities
  - e. Goal for each church to have a Prayer Coordinator, appointed by church leadership who will work with the pastor and church leadership to develop a prayer team whose members are from each of the ministries in the church. Develop a "Culture of Prayer" in every church. Recognize that the spiritual future of a church and church growth can be predicted based on its prayer life.
- 6. Prayer Retreat: Annual Event
- 7. Team Members consist of Area Prayer Leaders, Pastors, and Conference Liaison. Members will collectively demonstrate a passion for the ministry of prayer and work together with skills of Administration, Organization, Music (worship), Communication, Computer IT, encouragement, and helps, and teaching.
- 8. Work with, encourage and support Hispanic Prayer Ministries
- 9. Support General Conference, NAD, and SECC Conference Prayer initiatives.
  - a. Day of Prayer every quarter
  - b. 7/7/7: 7 Days a Week, 7 a.m. and 7:p.m.
    - <u>Pray Up</u>: Pray upward for a personal relationship with God, for revival and for transformation.
    - <u>Pray In</u>: Pray inward for our churches to become Houses of Prayer and for church unity.
    - <u>Pray Out</u>: Pray outward for our communities and for God to open new opportunities.
